OLD BUSINESS

Bonnaroo- Volunteers would ideally volunteer for all 4 days. They are asking volunteers to work a morning, mid-day, and evening shift. An email is coming with all the “perks”. The volunteers must be 18 yrs old. Will post on facebook for volunteers. 75 volunteers = \$10,000. The volunteers must attend a prep class prior to the event. Would like the volunteer list by the beginning of May. Event dates: June 13th-16th.

Props and Trailers- Will probably reuse the stage and boards. Will try to remodel the shell into something. Looking at trying to make the front of a subway train. The idea of the show is different stops in the city. We continue to look for a new trailer for hauling props/uniforms but can also be used as a changing room.

Solo and ensemble- Hospitality breakfast and concessions stand. We will need some parent volunteers to come up with a menu for the concessions. Will start @ 9a with cascade students to begin. Other schools will probably start arriving around 10a. Will have a little bit of breakfast for the judges and a few band directors. Will have 5 judges. Maybe also have a sandwich tray or use the leftovers from the Jazz band concert.

The Banquet date will be changed to May 14th @ Shelbyville Mills fellowship hall.

Fundraiser- Haven’t been able to get in touch with the popcorn company yet. We currently don’t have a back-up if Leteta can’t get in touch. We do have all the info for the Krispie Cream Donuts.

Band Booster Positions- Would anyone want to keep their current positions?

Dawn and Mark have been working on a pamphlet for new band parents with information that “we wish we knew”.

Uniforms have all been cleaned except for the seniors. After the spring concert, Dawn will take the costumes home and repair any that need to be repaired and washed.

Mrs. Sorrells approved for us to paint the parking spots for the band trailers.

NEW BUSINESS

Props and Trailers: Need running lights, routine maintenance on the old trailers, working on the new trailer, need a hitch lock and 3 locks for the doors on the new trailer. We will still use the 4 boards, stage and half shell again. Would like to create the front of a subway car.

Jazz Band dinner and Silent Auction: Donations continue to roll in. Doug Smith is donating 8 pork butts for barbeque. Mandy will be cooking 4 pork butts also and the band will buy 4 more. Dawn is doing the baked beans, We will get potato salad from Palmer's. To-go boxes will be made prior to serving for all the Jazz band kids. Will also need cups, plates, silverware, to-go boxes. The kids will bring dessert. There will be a condiment table and dessert table outside of the serving area. We will also have 2 lines to help things move quicker. Dinner will be from 6p-7:45p, the silent auction will be from 6p-8p. Set-up will start right after school is over. Servers- Anise, Amanda, Leteta, Amanda, James, Phil plus several kid volunteers.

Tidal Wave Fundraiser: We get 50% of everything. We will pay \$5 for every coupon and sell them for \$10 each. We will plan to sell these cards at the Band Camp preview show.

Band Camp Fee will go up to \$175 per student

We are still waiting on information regarding Bonnaroo. Will send out an email and post on social media for interest in working Bonnaroo.

Trailer Spots: We have been approved 6 spots to paint for the trailers.

Solo and Ensemble: We will set up a signup genius for volunteers and food for the hospitality room. We will have a concessions stand for the students. Students can work the concessions stand with 1 adult. We will sell BBQ sandwiches, Chips, Candy Bars, Soda, bottles water, sweet tea, and hot dogs.

Band Banquet: Mandy will be in charge of the food. We will do Chicken Alfredo, pasta, salad, garlic rolls, and dessert. The Lucich family will provide the senior gifts. Austin will need to meet with the church IT people to make sure everything works properly.
