Band Camp: Freshman day July 15th. Will have BBQ sandwiches and baked beans for lunch. Will have breakfast snacks every morning before camp.

Meals for the week: Monday- taco salad, Tuesday- chicken fettuccine, Wednesday- Pizza and salad, Thursday- Bell Buckle café, Friday- Hamburgers and hotdogs

Will create a sign-up genius for helpers during band camp (uniforms, meals/prep, set-up, outside, and tear-down). Will need tents, weights, fans, bring their own water bottles, sunscreen (pre-apply), etc.

Will get the ice cream cups again this year for the ice cream social. Will need, spoons, bowls and toppings. Will have tents set up with tables for volunteer sign-ups: trailer pullers/pit helpers, concessions, letterman jackets, shirts, chaperone/sandwich makers, uniform helpers, hats.

Mr. Lucich will be ordering the hoodies and shoes once school starts.

Props- We will need 4 maybe 5 trailers this year. The current estimate for the concert shell is \$700-750. A trailer of wood has been donated. Board approved the purchase for the shell. Phil and Amanda will be donating LED lights. Need approval for \$300 for 4 portable power supplies and \$80-100 for 2 smoke machines. Approved \$1100 for props at this time.

Uniforms- 33 boys and 31 girls having costumes made for competitions. Will cost \$30 per person. Will need lots of help to cut, trim, iron, etc. Girls will need knee high socks. Boys will need crew socks. Total of ~ \$2000 for fabric purchase approved. Will need more hangers and guard bags ordered.

Fundraising ideas: Fill in the Calendar- 100% profit, Krispie Kreme- 50% profit, Pretzels- 50% profit, butter breads- \$8.50 profit, hats/slides/mugs. Approved to do fruit and butter breads (cake rolls) together instead of fudge. Tentative fundraisers: Fruit and Butter breads (august), Calendar (October).
